- This competition allows each Congressional District to submit one piece of artwork for display in the U.S. Capitol for the duration of one year. Visitors from all over the world will be able to view artwork from high school artists from around the country.
- This contest is open to all currently enrolled high school students. Please make sure you read the guidelines carefully, as any artwork that does not meet these requirements will automatically be disqualified.
- Students should have their entries submitted to our Evansville, IN or Terre Haute, IN district offices by Friday, April 19, 2013. Art submissions can also be made to our Vincennes, IN office on April 17, 2013 from 9am to 4pm EST, or to our Jasper, IN office on April 18, 2013 from 9am to 4pm EST.
- On April 29th, all submissions will be posted online in a photo album on my Facebook.com page, as well as on my website.
- From April 29th through May 4th, the submissions will be displayed in Evansville, at the Main Street Gallery of the Arts Council of Southwestern Indiana. Details and additional information for this display will be announced when they become available.
- Judging of the artwork will be conducted by an expert panel from the Arts Council of Southwestern Indiana.
- The individual with the winning piece of art will receive:
 1. two free roundtrip tickets to Washington, DC from Southwest Airlines
 2. a gift card for the Marriot Hotel chains
 3. tours of the Capitol and the White House
 4. an invitation to the Congressional awards ceremony
