- Student with the winning art piece will receive two roundtrip tickets from Southwest Airlines to Washington, D.C., tours of the Capitol and the White House and an invitation to the Congressional awards ceremony.
- Submissions will be displayed in Evansville at the Main Street Gallery of the Arts Council of Southwestern Indiana.
